

RAGNOT CAMP RULES

CAMPER and PARENT Must Read and Sign

CLUB RULES:

1. Shoes must be worn at all times except when swimming.
2. Dry shirts and shoes must be worn on the 2nd & 3rd floor at all times.
3. No swimming in the harbor. – No exceptions.
4. Do not enter the bar or dining area.

CAMP RULES:

1. Parents do not contact your child during the camp session or instruct your child to contact you. All communication must go through the camp directors via the club office.
2. I will cooperate with and obey camp directors, coaches and counselors.
3. I will respect the property of my fellow campers and will not borrow boat parts or personal articles.
4. **Campers are not permitted to charge items on your club account.**
5. Regular medication that child needs to take must include labeled directions, physician's name, and date of prescription before a member of the staff can dispense it. Please attach daily dispensing schedule. See Medical Release for details.
6. Lifejackets, hats, shirts, sunscreen and sunglasses MUST be worn on the water at all times.
7. Doors will remain unlocked at all times.
8. **All food in designated eating areas only. No food or liquids in ballroom.**
9. No one leaves his or her sleeping area after 9:30 p.m. except in an emergency.
10. All Lights out at 10:00 p.m.
11. No horseplay/rough-housing/running indoors.
12. **No one will be in the sleeping areas during activities. All campers must participate in and follow scheduled activities. No camper has permission to supervise himself during group activities.**
13. **Do not bring valuables, money, electronics, cellphones, Gameboys, PSP's, Ipods, MP3 players, etc. If you are in doubt, do not bring it.**
14. No camper may leave camp for any reason at any time.
15. No driving anywhere. Car keys will be turned in to Camp Directors.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will respect fellow campers, coaches, counselors and club staff.
2. I will be on my best behavior as my actions reflect on Houston Yacht Club. Members and their guests will be at the club while camp is in session.
3. I will follow all coach's instructions particularly those relating to safety.

I WILL FOLLOW ALL HOUSTON YACHT CLUB CLUBHOUSE, HARBOR, AND CAMP RULES AS LISTED ABOVE.

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES CAN RESULT IN THE CAMPER BEING DISMISSED FROM CAMP.

RAGNOT CAMP PACKING CHECKLIST

PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS A CAMPER BRINGS TO CAMP, INCLUDING BOAT PARTS

Use a small duffel bag and/or a laundry basket to transport your gear.

Bedding:

- Pillow
- Sleeping bag or blankets and sheets
- Cot or air mattress

Personal toiletries:

- Comb/brush
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo
- Soap
- Sunscreen with SPF of 30 or above – check for adverse reaction prior to camp
- “Chapstick” with sunscreen. Note: many lip screens do not have sunscreen.
- Mosquito repellent
- Zinc oxide

Personal Items:

- Medication – Labeled and given to Camp Directors. See Medical Release for details.
- Sunglasses – Restraining strap recommended
- Hat with Brim - Restraining strap recommended
- Lifejacket (Coast Guard Approved) with whistle – zipper type recommended, no buckles
- Water repellent jacket
- Net bag for wet items
- Flashlight with batteries

Clothes:

- 3 swimsuits
- 3 pairs of shorts
- 5 t-shirts
- 2 long-sleeved t-shirts
- 3 pairs of socks
- underwear
- 1 pair of sandals
- 1 pair white-soled tennis or boat shoes (campers are required to wear shoes on the piers, boats and in the Clubhouse at all times)

Long Sleeved sunscreen shirts have been very popular with the sailors and are highly recommended for ‘goof proofing’ sunprotection!!!!!!!
