NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The regatta is open to all keelboats, all Clubs.
- b. All classes are welcome.
- c. Potential classes may be: One Design (minimum 3 boats to make a class), PHRF Non-Spin and Spin and Club Handicap Non-Spin and Spin.
- d. Competitors racing under the Handicap System must have either a current PHRF-GB certificate, or a HYC club rating assigned by the Race Committee.
- e. Competitors enter the event by registering at the Competitor's Briefing 12:00 noon in the HYC Main Bar.

3. FEES

- a. There is no entry fee.

4. SCHEDULE

- a. Sunday, 01 January 2017: 12:00 Noon - Competitor's briefing in the HYC main bar - upper level.
- b. Sunday, 01 January 2017 at approximately 1:30 p.m. - Start Time.
- c. Sunday, 01 January 2017 at approximately 4:00 p.m. - Awards in the HYC main bar - upper level.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. The Sailing Instructions will be distributed at the Competitor's Briefing.

6. VENUE

- a. All races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Houston Yacht Club in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by Morgan's Point on the North, the Bayport Ship Channel on the south, the Houston Ship Channel on the East, and the La Porte/Shoreacres shoreline.

7. THE COURSES

- a. All classes will race windward-leeward pursuit style course as identified in the sailing instructions.

8. SCORING

- a. One race is scheduled. Finish position is based on the order of finish, i.e., pursuit style race.

9. BERTHING

- a. Contact the HYC Harbormaster on VHF Radio Channel 68 or 281-471-1255 for temporary slip assignment for the Regatta.

10. PRIZES

- a. Trophies are, as of yet, undetermined - but certain to be of a highly desirable nature.
- b. Black-eyed peas and cornbread served during trophy presentation!

- a. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
